1 Wave by Thea Vesterby

Wave is a top-down sweater that is worked in two colours. It features a lovely, wave-like lace pattern on body and sleeves.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4) (5, 6, 7)

Recommended ease: 2–6" / 5–15 cm of positive ease.

Finished Chest Circumference: 28 (33.75, 39.25, 45) (50.5, 56, 61.75)" / 70 (84, 98, 112) (126, 140, 154) cm.

YARN

Double Sunday by Sandnes Garn (100% merino, 118 yds / 108 m – 50 g).

MC: 8 (9, 11, 13) (16, 17, 18) balls of colourway 4626 Pink.

CC: 2 (3, 3, 4) (4, 5, 5) balls of colourway 3819 That Orange Feeling by PetiteKnit.

Or approx. 855 (975, 1235, 1490) (1820, 1965, 2105) yds / 785 (895, 1130, 1365) (1665, 1800, 1930) m (in MC) and 215 (245, 310, 375) (455, 495, 530) yds / 200 (225, 285, 345) (420, 450, 485) m (in CC) of DK-weight yarn.

2 Linescapes by Veronika Lindberg / Kutovakika

Linescapes is a super cosy cardigan worked on US 11 / 8 mm needles which makes it a quick project to finish. Purl rows create a subtle striped effect that together with the fold-down collar gives the design a subtle vintage vibe. Wear this cardigan on chilly summer evenings with a floral dress and boots or styled with a pair of relaxed jeans and sneakers when going to the city.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8)

Recommended ease: 8–14" / 20–36 cm of positive ease.

Finished Bust Circumference: 45.5 (52, 54.25, 58.75, 60.75) (65.25, 70.25, 74.75)" /

114 (130, 136, 147, 152) (163, 176, 187) cm.

YARN

13 (14, 15, 16, 17) (18, 19, 20) skeins of Snefnug by CaMaRose (55% alpaca, 35% cotton, 10% extra fine merino, 120 yds / 110 m – 50 g), colourway 7864 Havgron.

Or approx. 1180 (1570, 1905, 2060, 2385) (2560, 3050, 3615) yds / 1080 (1435, 1745, 1885, 2185) (2345, 2795, 3310) m of bulky-weight yarn.

The sweater is worked holding two strands of yarn together.

3 Sound of Spring by Lene Tosti

Sound of Spring is a slightly asymmetrical triangular shawl knitted on the bias. It features an adorable lace stitch knitted in two colours.

SIZES

1 (2, 3)

Finished Wingspan: 54 (76, 90)" / 137 (193, 229) cm. **Finished Centre Depth:** 13.5 (19, 22)" / 34 (48, 56) cm.

YARN

Cottage Merino by Walk Collection (100% merino, 394 yds / 360 m – 100 g).

MC: 1 (2, 3) skein(s) in colourway Apricot.

CC: 1 skein in colourway Chartreuse.

Or approx. 394 (765, 1137) yds / 360 (700, 1040) m (in MC) and 125 (202, 274) yds / 115 (185, 251) m (in CC) of fingering-weight yarn.

4 Dress to Impress by Julia Disini

Dress to Impress is a fluffy, oversized cardigan designed for moments when you want to feel gorgeous without needing to dress up otherwise. Thoughtful design choices make this a modern, wearable piece.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: Up to 16" / 40 cm of positive ease.

Finished Bust Circumference (buttoned): 48 (50.25, 54.5, 58.75, 63) (67.25, 71.5, 75.75, 80)" / 123 (128, 139, 149, 160) (171, 181, 192, 203) cm.

YARN

10 (10, 11, 11, 12) (12, 13, 14, 14) skeins of Chunky Mohair by Kokon (78% mohair, 13% merino wool, 9% nylon, 109 yds / 100 m – 50 g), colourway Moon.

Or approx. 1010 (1035, 1100, 1140, 1210) (1290, 1370, 1450, 1530) yds / 925 (950, 1010, 1045, 1110) (1180, 1255, 1330, 1400) m of similar kind of chunky-weight yarn.

5 Aamuyö by Pauliina Leisti

Aamuyö is a seamless top-down cardigan with a relaxed fit and shorter sleeves. It features a textural stitch pattern that is created using two different yarns: silk mohair and alpaca. The button band completes the sophisticated look.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 4–6" / 10–15 cm of positive ease.

Finished Bust Circumference: 35.5 (38.75, 43.25, 47, 51.5) (55.25, 59.25, 63.25, 67.25)" / 89 (97, 108, 118, 129) (138, 148, 158, 168) cm.

YARN

Yarn A: 6 (7, 7, 8, 9) (10, 11, 12, 13) skeins of Lace Mohair Superkid Silk by Lang (58% mohair, 42% silk, 339 yds / 310 m – 25 g), colourway 992.0039 held triple.

Or approx. 1893 (2131, 2367, 2626, 2886) (3196, 3484, 3891, 4201) yds / 1731 (1949,

2165, 2401, 2639) (2922, 3186, 3558, 3841) m of similar lace-weight yarn.

Note! Yarn A can be substituted with a silk mohair yarn that has 218–240 yds / 200–220 m per 25 g held double.

Yarn B: 2 (2, 3, 3, 3) (3, 4, 4, 5) skeins of Baby Alpaca by Lang (100% baby alpaca, 186 yds / 170 m – 50 g), colourway 719.0198.

Or approx. 351 (394, 437, 483, 530) (586, 639, 712, 768) yds / 321 (360, 399, 442, 485) (536, 584, 651, 702) m of sport-weight alpaca yarn.

6 JingWoo by Rastus Hsu

JingWoo means a house of mirrors in Mandarin and is inspired by geometric origami squares. This piece is a fun and relaxing knit for anyone who enjoys creating a fascinating fabric with simple stitches.

SIZE

One Size

Finished Length: 85" / 216 cm. Finished Width: 14.5" / 37 cm.

YARN

5 skeins of Opus by Walcot Yarns (70% Argentinian merino, 30% baby alpaca, 384 yds / 350 m – 100 g), colourway Aperol.

Or approx. 1920 yds / 1750 m of sport-weight yarn.

7 Kainuu by Maija Vasala

Kainuu is named after the region in Finland where Maija, the designer, grew up. Berry and leaf motifs sprouting around the sweater are modified from the mittens traditionally knitted in Kainuu. A cropped hem and a loose fit give this folklore inspired design a modern look.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended positive ease: 2-6" / 5-15 cm.

Finished Bust Circumference: 37.25 (41, 44.25, 48.75, 52.75) (56, 60, 64, 68)" / 93.5 (102.5, 111, 121.5, 131.5) (140, 150, 160, 170) cm.

YARN

Tukuwool Fingering (100% Finnish wool, 219 yds / 200 m – 50 g).

MC: 4 (5, 5, 5, 6) (6, 7, 7, 8) skeins, colourway Sake. Or approx. 800 (883, 957, 1055, 1144) (1271, 1384, 1499, 1609) yds / 732 (807, 875, 965, 1046) (1162, 1266, 1371, 1471) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC1: 1 skein, colourway Kajo. Or approx. 48 (53, 58, 64, 64) (69, 69, 77, 83) yds / 44 (48, 53, 59, 59) (63, 63, 70, 76) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC2: 1 skein, colourway Rohto. Or approx. 48 (53, 58, 64, 64) (69, 69, 77, 83) yds / 44 (48, 53, 59, 59) (63, 63, 70, 76) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC3: 1 skein, colourway Haave. Or approx. 43 (48, 52, 57, 57) (62, 62, 69, 75) yds / 39 (44, 48, 52, 52) (57, 57, 63, 69) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC4: 1 skein, colourway Syli. Or approx. 67 (74, 81, 89, 89) (96, 96, 107, 117) yds / 61 (68, 74, 81, 81) (88, 88, 98, 107) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC5: 1 skein, colourway Havu. Or approx. 19 (21, 23, 25, 25) (28, 28, 31, 33) yds / 17 (19, 21, 23, 23) (26, 26, 28, 30) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC6: 1 skein, colourway Lehto. Or approx. 34 (37, 40, 44, 44) (48, 48, 54, 58) yds / 31 (34, 37, 40, 40) (44, 44, 49, 53) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC7: 1 skein, colourway Repo. Or approx. 53 (58, 63, 70, 70) (76, 76, 84, 92) yds / 48 (53, 58, 64, 64) (69, 69, 77, 84) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC8: 1 skein, colourway Polte. Or approx. 48 (53, 58, 64, 64) (69, 69, 77, 83) yds / 44 (48, 53, 59, 59) (63, 63, 70, 76) m of fingering-weight yarn.

8 Liberty by Pope Vergara

Liberty is a light-weight sweater for carefree summer days. It features delicate ruffles on the body, beads on the neckline and cuffs, golden thread along the ruffle edges and puff sleeves.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommend ease: 0–1" / 0–2.5 cm of positive ease.

Finished Bust Circumference: 35 (37.25, 39, 40.75, 45.5) (49.75, 53.5, 57.75, 61.5)" / 88 (93, 98, 102, 114) (124, 134, 144, 154) cm.

YARN

Yarn A: 1 (1, 1, 2, 2) (2, 2, 2, 3) skein(s) of Marina by Manos del Uruguay (100% wool, 874 yds / 800 m - 100 g), colourway Solana. Or approx. 569 (670, 874, 1050, 1181) (1356, 1542, 1717, 1892) yds / 520 (640, 800, 960, 1080) (1240, 1410, 1570, 1730) m of lace-weight yarn.

Yarn B: 3 (3, 4, 5, 5) (6, 7, 8, 8) skeins of Silk Mohair by Isager (75% kid mohair, 25% silk, 231 yds / 212 m – 25 g), colourway 66. Or approx. 569 (670, 875, 1049, 1080) (1356, 1541, 1716, 1892) yds / 520 (640, 800, 960, 1080) (1240, 1410, 1570, 1730) m of lace-weight yarn.

Both yarns are held together throughout the pattern.

Yarn C for the binding off the ruffles: A couple of yds / metres of Mineral Silk by Purl Soho (75% silk, 25% synthetic sparkle, 394 yds / 360 m – 50 g), colourway Gold.

9 Seashells by Marie Régnier

Seashells is worked from the top down flat and in the rnd. It features an intuitive, straightforward construction to enhance the textured ribbed pattern of the fabric and the decorative crochet edges at the neckline and armholes. This design is inspired by happy sunny days at the beach and combines the vibrant colour of the sun with sea creatures (intricate details of the Plaited Rib pattern and scalloped crochet edge).

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9, 10)

Recommended ease: 0–4" / 0–10 cm of positive ease.

Finished Bust Circumference: 32 (35.5, 38.5, 43, 47.5) (52, 53.75, 58.5, 63, 67.5)" / 80 (88.5, 96, 108, 119) (130.5, 135, 146, 158, 169) cm.

YARN

4 (5, 6, 7, 8) (9, 9, 10, 12, 13) balls of Tencel-Cotton by Katia (67% lyocell, 33% cotton, 131 yds / 120 m – 50 g), colourway 14 Lemon Yellow.

Or approx. 500 (600, 750, 800, 920) (1100, 1150, 1300, 1500, 1600) yds / 455 (530, 660, 725, 835) (980, 1050, 1200, 1350, 1450) m of DK-weight yarn.

10 Utopia by Elena Solier Jansà

Utopia is a cropped pullover with 3/4 sleeves. It features an easy and elegant lace pattern on the body and Stockinette Stitch on the sleeves. The knitted fabric is loose and drapey, perfect for summer.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4, 5) (6, 7, 8, 9)

Recommended ease: 5–7.75" / 12.5–20 cm of positive ease.

Finished Chest Circumference: 36 (39, 45, 48, 50.75) (54, 60, 63, 66)" / 91.5 (99, 114, 122, 129) (137, 152, 160, 167.5) cm.

YARN

5 (6, 6, 7, 7) (8, 8, 9, 9) skeins of Pastoreta by Xolla (100% Ripollesa wool, 213 yds / 195 m – 50 g), colourway Fossil.

Or approx. 920 (970, 1120, 1190, 1310) (1370, 1580, 1720, 1770) yds / 840 (890, 1020, 1090, 1200) (1260, 1450, 1580, 1630) m of fingering-weight yarn.

11 Socks à la Mode by Jacquline Rivera

Inspired by Jacquline Rivera's summers on the New Jersey boardwalk, *Socks À La Mode* encapsulates the best part of summer — frozen custard in a waffle cone from Kohr Brothers.

SIZES

1 (2, 3, 4)

Finished Foot Circumference: 7 (8, 9, 10)" / 18 (20.5, 23, 25.5) cm.

YARN

Smooth Sock by The Uncommon Thread (75% superwash Bluefaced Leicester wool, 25% nylon, 465 yds / 425 m – 100 g).

MC: 1 hank in colourway Julep. Or approx. 186 (205, 228, 247) yds / 170 (187, 208, 226) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC1: 1 hank in colourway Sorbet. Or approx. 28 (33, 37, 42) yds / 26 (30, 34, 38) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC2: 1 hank in colourway Brassica. Or approx. 56 (61, 70, 75) yds / 51 (56, 64, 69) m of fingering-weight yarn.

CC3: 1 hank in colourway Fe203. Or approx. 56 (61, 70, 75) yds / 51 (56, 64, 69) m of fingering-weight yarn.
